In February 2015, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy) notified you that it had filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The CCN application requested authorization for CenterPoint Energy to construct new 138 kV transmission facilities either on or in close proximity to your property. The CCN application was assigned to Docket No. 44242.

The PUC issued the Order in Docket No. 44242 on May 4, 2015, in which Alternative Route 8 (Segments B, H, N, V, AA, AF, AI, AM), which is shown on the attached map, was designated as the route along which CenterPoint Energy is authorized to construct the new transmission facilities. The route that was approved by the PUC does not cross your property, and your property is no longer the subject of a pending proceeding.
