

## Gas Price Update

### Natural gas prices drop slightly and remain low for April

While the early spring inclement weather at the end of March is expected to provide a modest bump in natural gas demand, it's too late in the withdrawal season to substantially impact the robust supply. Natural gas in storage at the end of March was 41% more than the five-year average, 21% more than last year at this time, and 15% more than the five-year maximum accounting to the Energy Information Administration. Moving further into spring and what is referred to as the shoulder season when there is typically less U.S. natural gas consumption than at other times of the year because of warmer temperatures, demand is expected to drop helping to keep gas prices low.


