

What Work Might Be Done on my Home?

First, an energy audit will be performed on your home to identify what could be done to help you save energy. Then, typical work would include one or more of the following approved U.S. Department of Energy weatherization services:

- Insulation of attics, walls, floors, foundations, sill boxes and/or duct work
- Duct sealing/repair
- Air infiltration reduction (caulk, repair and/or replace leaking walls, floors, ceilings, roofs, doors and/or windows)
- Storm windows
- Low-flow shower heads
- Furnace tune-up or replacement
- Air conditioner tune-up or replacement
- Heat pump tune-up or replacement
- Refrigerator replacement
- Lighting retrofit
- Water heater tank or pipe insulation, or water heater replacement

Who is Eligible?

You may be eligible if:

- You are a residential heating or cooling customer of at least one AWP Utility; and
- Your home (site-constructed or mobile home) was built before 1997; and
- Your home is severely energy-inefficient, if at least three of these conditions exist:
 - ✓ Attic insulation equal to or less than R-30
 - ✓ Wall insulation equal to R-0
 - ✓ Floor insulation equal to R-0
 - ✓ Single pane windows with no storm windows attached
 - ✓ Non-working heating system or heating system with less than 70% efficiency
 - ✓ Non-working cooling system or cooling system with Seasonal Energy Efficiency Rating (SEER) of 8 or less
 - ✓ Air infiltration problems identified through (a) visual inspection of duct-work, walls, floors, ceilings, doors, and windows, or (b) a pre-blower test

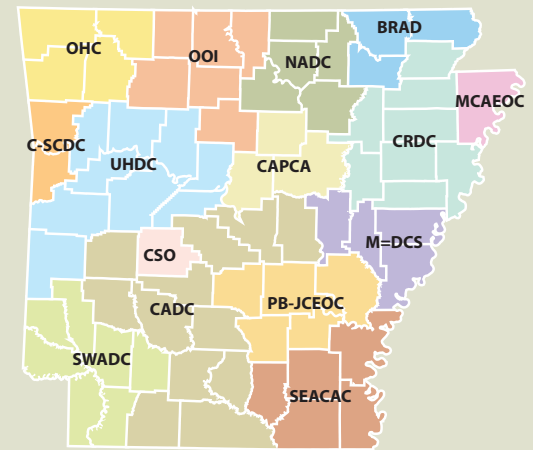
