Thunder Pipeline Non-Binding Open Season

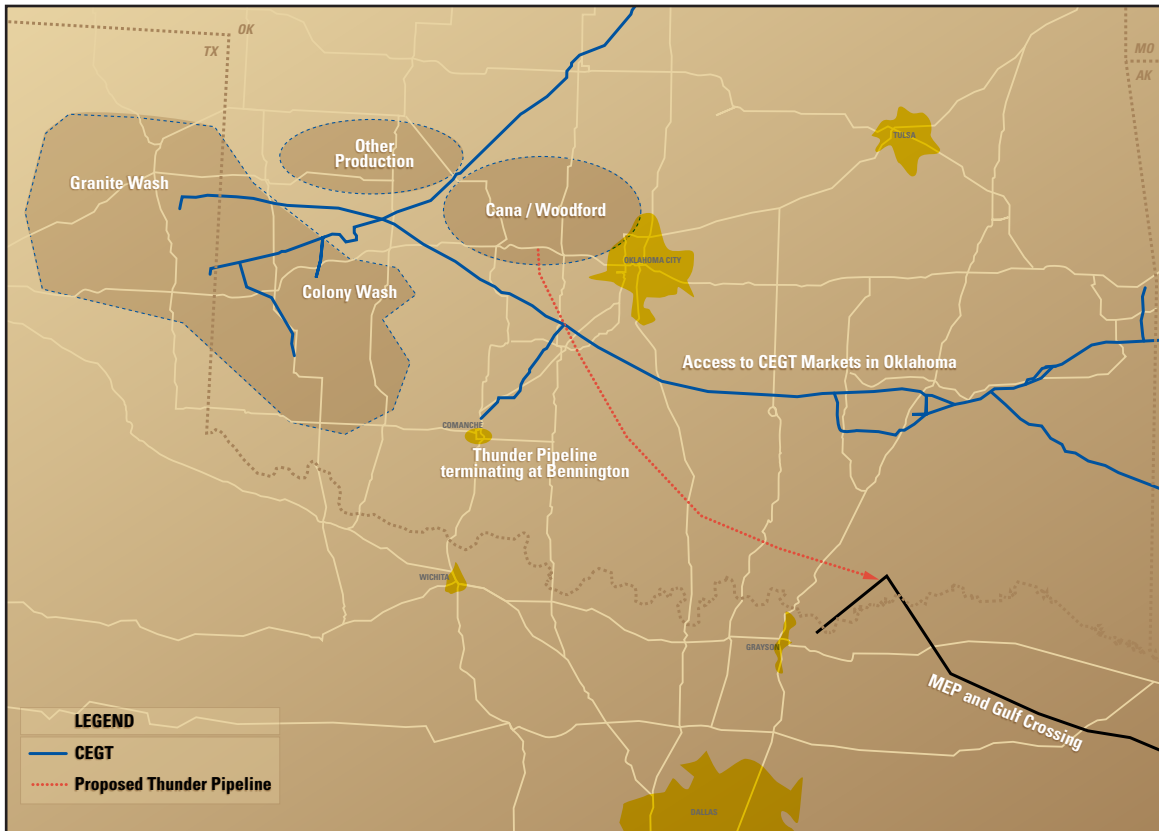
June 14, 2011 – July 14, 2011

CenterPoint Energy - Thunder Pipeline Company, LLC (Thunder), is announcing a non-binding open season for firm capacity on a new intrastate pipeline originating in western Oklahoma. As a result of the growth in the western Oklahoma areas such as Cana/Woodford, Granite Wash and Colony Wash, Thunder will be conducting this non-binding open season to seek expressions of interest for a new intrastate pipeline. The pipeline will serve this production corridor for delivery to markets in Oklahoma, and downstream interconnects with other intrastate and interstate pipelines, including Bennington, OK area pipelines and CenterPoint Energy Gas Transmission Company's (CEGT) Line AD.

Thunder anticipates the new line's capacity will be between 1.0 and 1.3 Bcf per day. The new pipeline, which originates in Canadian County, Okla., will be up to approximately 190 miles in length and will have approximately 90,000 horsepower of compression. The specific facilities required will depend on the location and level of commitment originating from each of the potential supply sources and requested delivery areas. Certain receipt points may provide greater operational and economic benefit and this may impact the facilities required, providing for a revised project scope. Thunder will consider these factors in its evaluation of the open season bids. Thunder will consider proposals of any contract term length, but anticipates that long-term commitments will be necessary to complete a project. Potential shippers should specify in detail the proposed rate, contract term, quantities and points.

Upon completion of the open season, if sufficient interest is shown, Thunder will evaluate all requests and determine whether to proceed with the project. Thunder will consider project scope when establishing rates and contract terms after giving consideration to optimized operating benefits, economic alternatives and projected capital costs. Thunder will then work with potential shippers who have submitted acceptable bids to complete binding precedent agreements to support the pipeline project.

Subject to its ability to secure sufficient binding commitments from creditworthy entities, in order to make the project economically viable, Thunder will seek appropriate regulatory authority to construct the facilities. Thunder reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to not accept any terms offered, or not to build an expansion due to uneconomic rates or terms.
