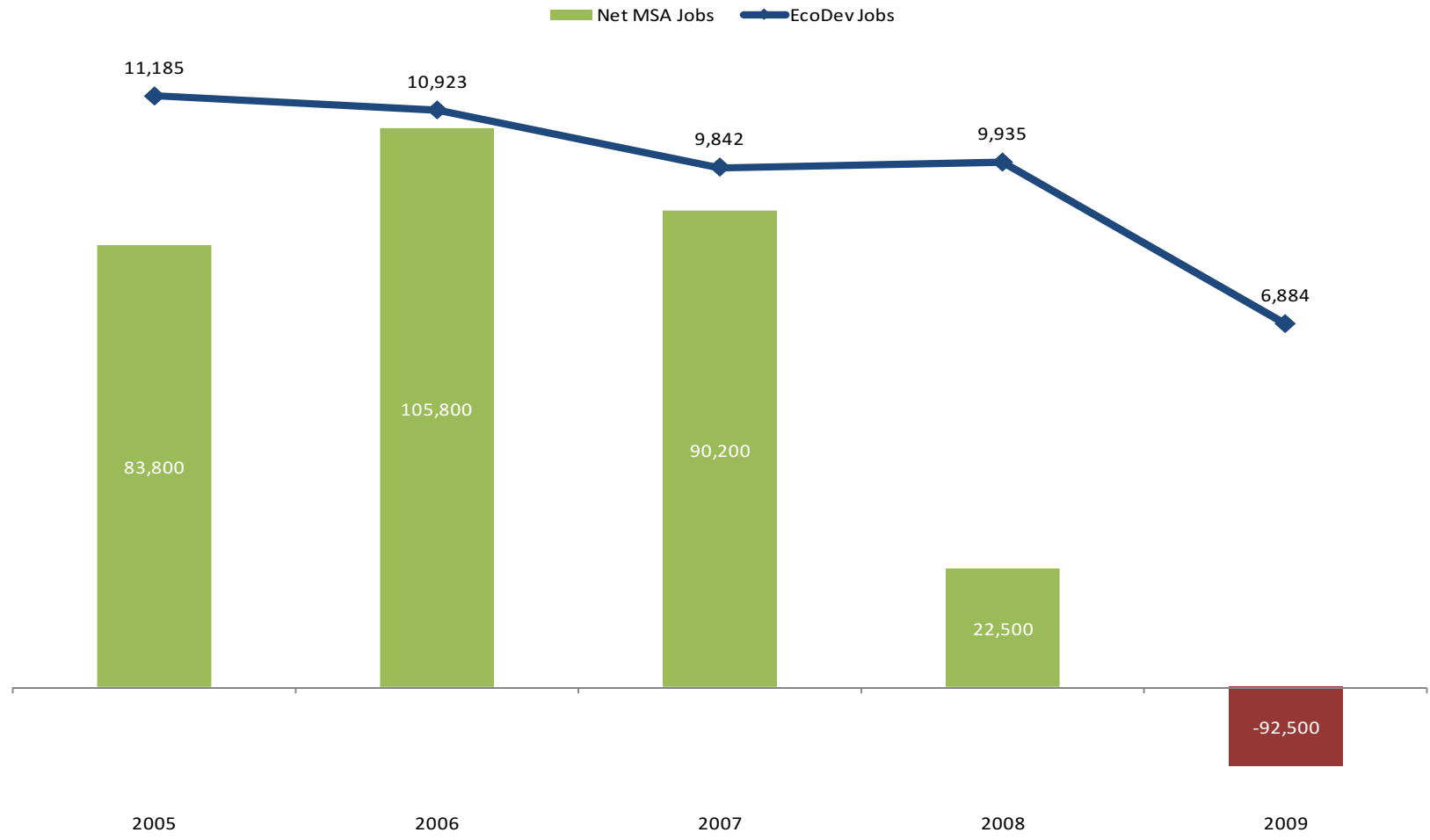

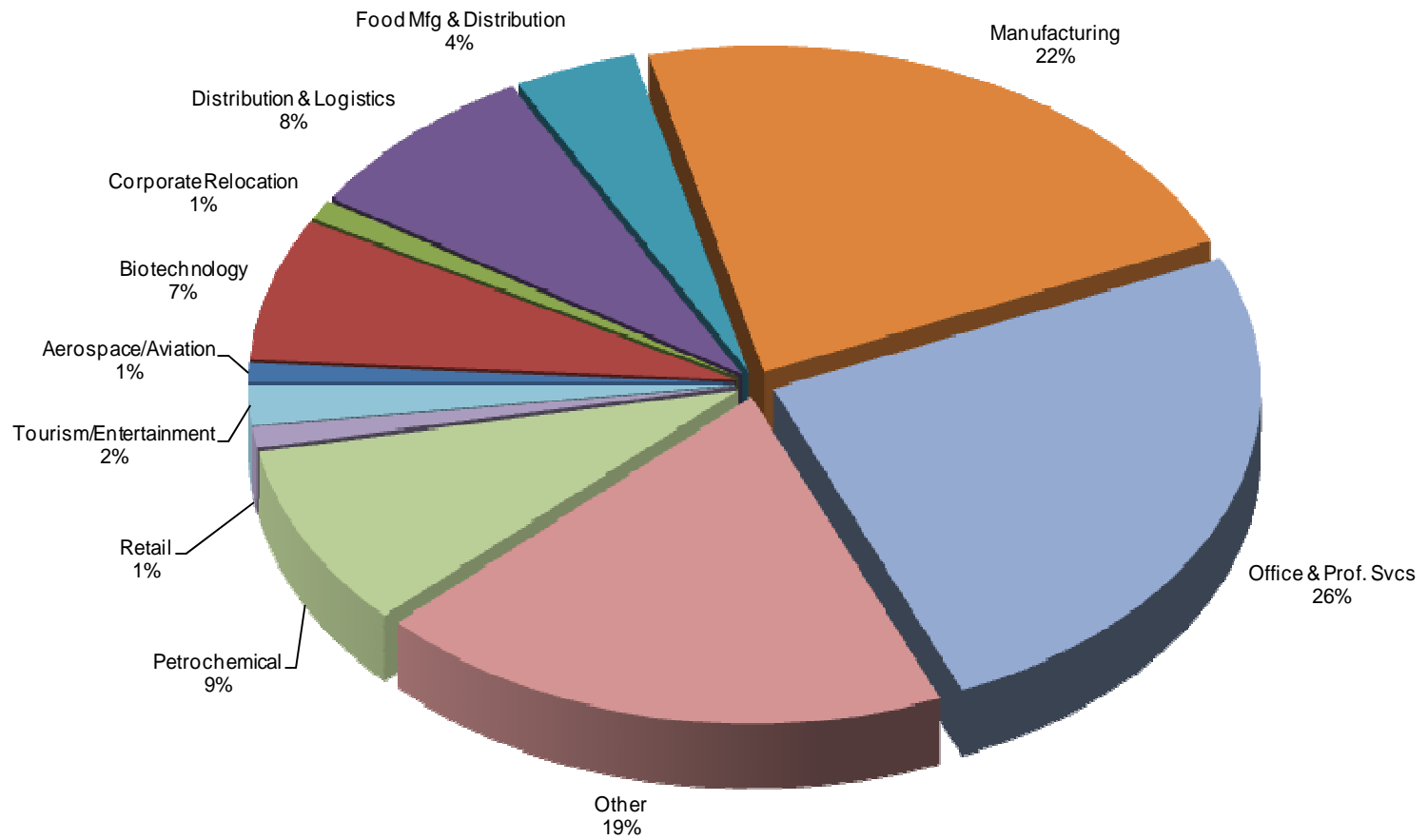

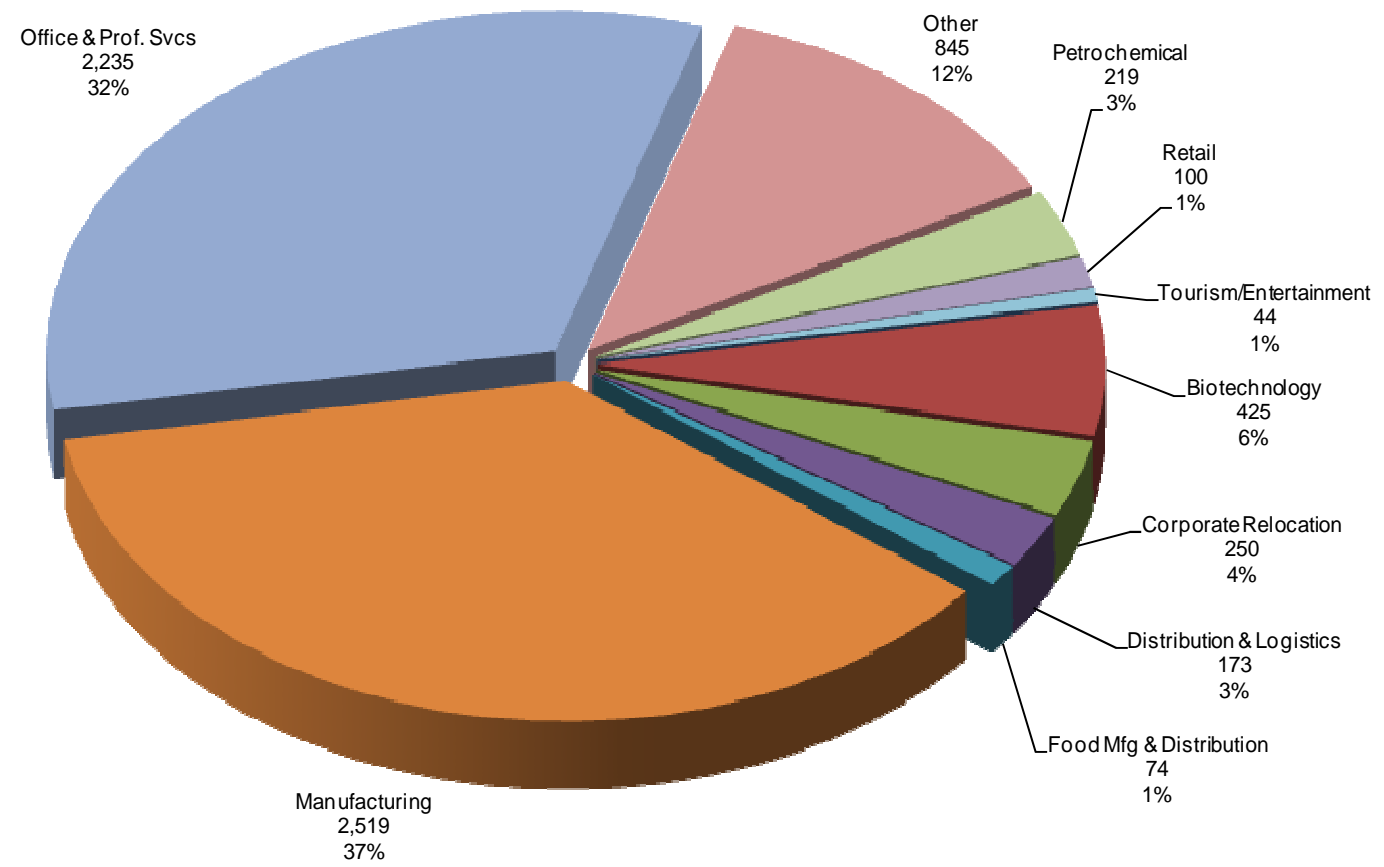

## 2009 Economic Development Consolidated Project Report New Jobs by Industry 6,884 Total Jobs



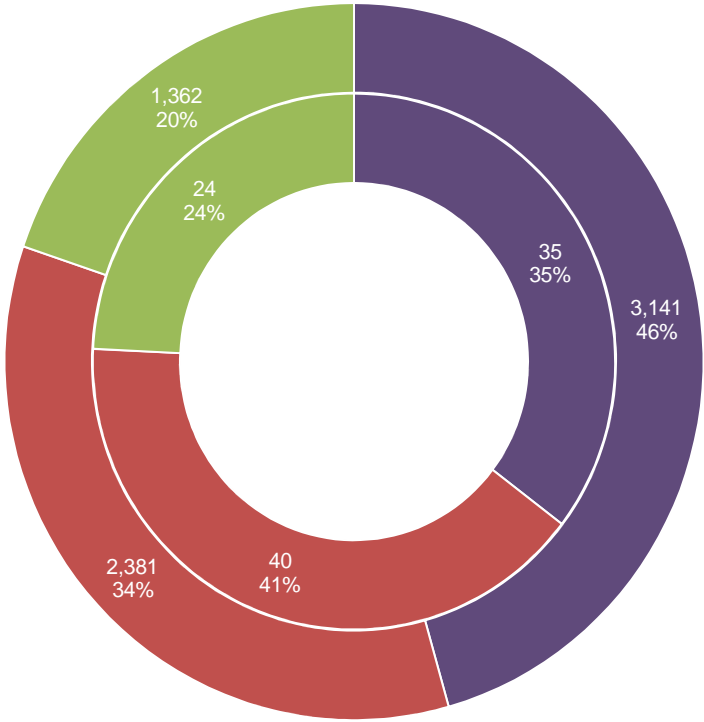

*Inner Ring – Projects, 99 Total*

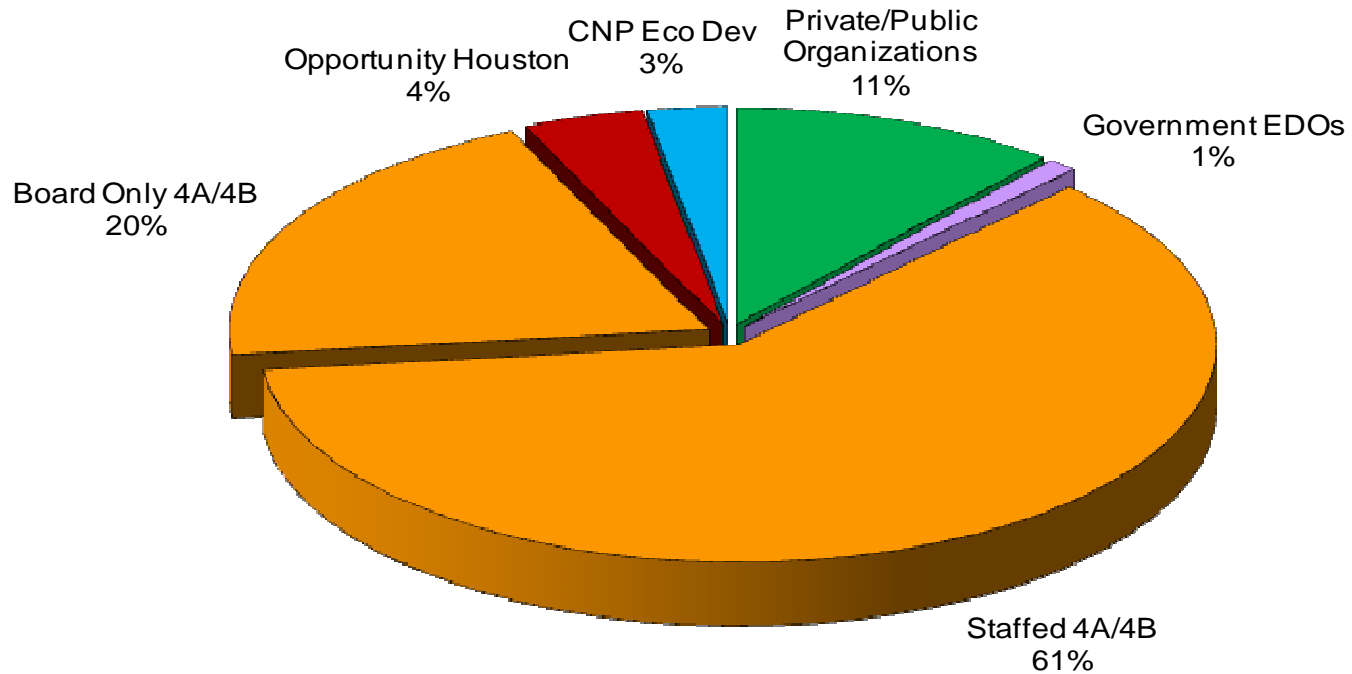
*Outer Ring – Jobs, 6,884 Total*

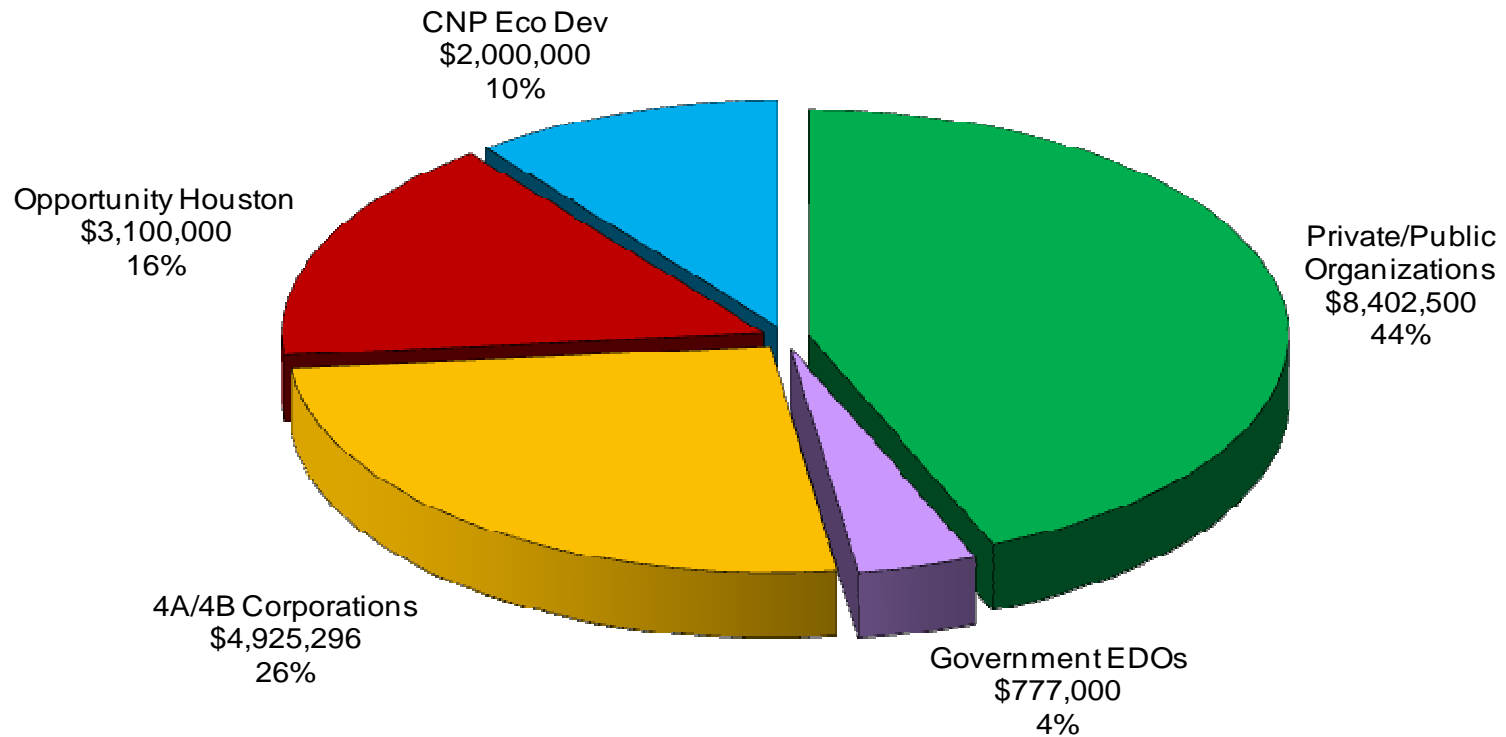


## Economic Development Funding for the Houston Area
