

SUMMARY OF CENTERPOINT ENERGY'S GENERAL POLE ATTACHMENT AGREEMENT REQUIREMENTS

PRELIMINARY REQUIREMENTS

- Copy of corporate documents (*Articles of Incorporation, Partnership Agreement, etc.*) evidencing Applicant Company's corporate identity.
- Copy of *Service Provider Certificate of Operating Authority (SPCOA)* issued by *Public Utility Commission of Texas* evidencing Applicant Company's operating authority and status.
- Map(s) or other information showing Applicant Company's intended geographic scope of operation.

LEGAL/FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Copy of *City Franchise Ordinance(s)* or formal authorization letter(s) from municipality (or municipalities) acknowledging Applicant Company's authority to construct within incorporated limit(s).
- *Certificate of Insurance* showing coverages in compliance with Pole Attachment Agreement Insurance Requirements (outlined in the Insurance Requirements Summary and detailed in Appendix "I" - Pole Attachment Bond and Insurance Requirements of the General Pole Attachment Agreement).
- *Pole Attachment Surety Bond* in a form containing the terms and conditions set forth in the sample bond Form of Bond for Pole Attachment Agreements and Exhibit "A" of the General Pole Attachment Agreement, and providing for an amount corresponding to the number of CNP poles anticipated for use (as outlined below):

1 to 100 poles	\$ 25,000
101 to 5,000 poles	\$ 50,000
5,001 to 10,000 poles	\$ 100,000
10,000+ poles	\$50,000 for each additional 5,000 poles
