

Why is my service out and the people across the street have their lights on?

- Overhead (OH) laterals are small branch circuits that branch off from the main circuit or feeder backbone known as feedermain.
- If the fuse on lateral 2, as shown below, is out, then all of the customers on that lateral are out.
- The customers that are out, on Second Avenue and Third Avenue, are across the street from customers that still have power since their fuse is not out.
