

Gas Price Update

Natural gas prices remain low moving into late spring

Warmer than normal temperatures, leading to higher than normal injections into storage, contributed to natural gas prices remaining at low levels for May. Speculation of a rebound in the U.S. economy will likely spur demand. However, ample storage supplies are available to meet this demand. Natural gas in storage is currently 19% above the five-year average and nearly 6% above a year ago.

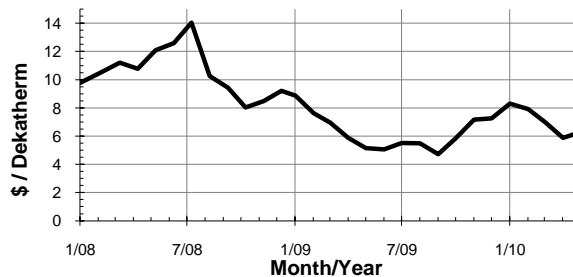
