In August 2013, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy) notified you that it had filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The CCN application requested authorization for CenterPoint Energy to construct new 138 kV transmission facilities on your property. The CCN application was assigned to Docket No. 41749.

The PUC issued the Order in Docket No. 41749 on January 27, 2014, in which Alternative Route 13 (Segments D, G, T, V, Y, CC), was designated as the route along which CenterPoint Energy is authorized to construct the new transmission facilities. Your land is located along the approved route, and CenterPoint Energy may need to obtain additional land rights from you. We are providing you a copy of the Order in Docket No. 41749 and a map showing the approved route for the transmission facilities.
