Key investments include:

Pipeline replacement

Nearly **400 miles** of bare steel and cast-iron pipes have been replaced.

System modernization

Approximately **30,000 new** advanced meters have been installed to enhance measurement accuracy and integrate safety features.

Service expansion

New service lines and more than 12,500 new gas service installations have been completed, expanding access in residential and business communities while supporting economic growth and development.

Transmission line upgrades

Large high-pressure pipelines have been upgraded to enhance safety and adhere to all updated regulatory standards.

Leak detection and mitigation

The deployment of **Picarro leak detection technology** has improved safety and reduced methane emissions.



CenterPoint Energy's Ohio natural gas business continues to make necessary investments to enhance system safety and reliability for approximately 333,000 customers in west-central Ohio.

Our efforts are focused on supporting regional initiatives and projects that strengthen both the economy and the communities we serve.



Economic Development

CenterPoint supports economic growth by extending natural gas service to transformative projects in west-central Ohio, contributing to job creation and regional development. The company has worked with local leaders on the following projects:

Menards: CenterPoint extended natural gas service to support Menards' manufacturing and distribution facility in Fayette County. This facility, key to the company's regional expansion, involved an \$81.5 million investment, creating 150 jobs.

Royal Canin: CenterPoint extended natural gas service to support the development of Royal Canin's pet food manufacturing facility in Preble County. This effort was instrumental in attracting the \$390 million investment, which created 224 new jobs in the region.



CenterPoint Energy Foundation and Community Relations

The CenterPoint Energy Foundation supports community engagement and development in west-central Ohio by leveraging everyday opportunities and resources to build vibrancy in those communities. The charitable foundation is funded by shareholders and has no impact on customer rates.

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library: As part of the effort to expand Dolly Parton's Imagination Library to every child in Ohio, the CenterPoint Energy Foundation provided a \$500,000 grant to provide all children aged 0-5 in our Dayton footprint access to free books each month.

Historic Dayton Arcade: As part of the renovation of the historic Dayton Arcade, the CenterPoint Energy Foundation provided \$1 million in funding for The Tank. A black box theatre, the Tank is used for events and entrepreneurial education and has hosted multiple podcasts and radio shows.

CenterPoint Energy Dayton Air Show: CenterPoint has been the title sponsor of the CenterPoint Energy Dayton Air Show since 2000, contributing an annual sponsorship fee of \$155,000, a commitment that has remained unchanged for more than two decades. This premier aviation event, with an annual economic impact of \$3.2 million, reinforces Dayton's heritage as the "Birthplace of Aviation" and supports community engagement, military recruitment and STEM education.
