IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS

1. Process boiler, boiler/burner tune-up and boiler economizer rebate amounts.

Equipment	Rebate Amount
Process Boiler (efficiency \geq 83% steam and \geq 85% hot water)	\$500 per MMBtu/hr input
Process Boiler Economizer (non-condensing)	\$500 per MMBtu/hr input
Process Boiler Economizer (condensing)	\$1000 per MMBtu/hr input
Process Equipment Tune-Up	25% of tune-up cost

2. If you are a trade ally, your six digit ID number is required to participate in the Trade Ally Incentive Program. If you do not know your ID#, please contact CenterPoint Energy at 612-321-4330.
3. All qualifying equipment must be fully installed and operational.
4. Enclose invoice showing separate figures for equipment, labor, and taxes.
5. All required information must be submitted before rebate can be paid.
6. Qualifying equipment must use natural gas provided by CenterPoint Energy in Minnesota for a commercial or industrial account.
7. Applications must be received by December 31 of the calendar year in which the equipment is installed. To avoid delays in rebate processing, please submit your paperwork as soon as equipment installation is complete.
8. Please allow six to eight weeks for rebate processing. Rebate checks will be issued to the name listed on the CenterPoint Energy account.

FOR TUNE-UPS:

1. All tune-up work must be completed as described to qualify for the rebate.
2. Technician must complete the following for each boiler that qualifies for a Boiler Tune-Up Rebate
 - Measure combustion efficiency using an electronic flue gas analyzer.
 - Adjust air flow and reduce excessive stack temperatures.
 - Adjust draft control.
 - Check adequacy of combustion air intake.
 - Clean fire side of heat exchanger.
3. Individual boilers are eligible for tune-up rebates only once every other year.
4. All required information must be submitted before rebate can be paid, including contractor invoice itemizing tune-up costs in the following categories:
 - Labor*
 - Analyzer charges*
 - Supplies (cleaning and CO2)*
 - Truck charges*

**Rebate paid on labor, analyzer, supplies required to perform tune-up and truck charges only.*

Post-combustion efficiency readings must also be submitted to CenterPoint Energy.
