as of 8 p.m., Friday, July 12

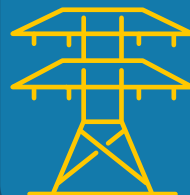
Hurricane Beryl made landfall on July 8, 2024 as a powerful Category 1 storm with substantial rain, storm surge and damaging winds. **Thousands of poles, lines and other electric equipment** were significantly damaged and more than **2.2 million** CenterPoint Energy customers were impacted before the storm left our service area.

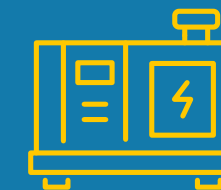
