PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

CenterPoint Energy's Multifamily Direct Install program offers property owners and managers a free visual audit of existing multifamily properties to determine eligibility for energy efficient direct install measures.

Measures include LED lights and water efficiency measures (faucet aerators for kitchen and bathroom, showerheads, and water heater pipe insulation).

Measures are installed at no cost to the eligible property and residents. Tenant education handouts are provided to residents to describe the benefits of energy efficiency and provide energy saving tips.

Only income-qualified properties at least 5 years old are eligible to participate.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS



01. CONTACT

Multifamily property developers or owners, property management or consulting companies can be a "Project Sponsor."

Project Sponsors begin by contacting the Program Manager, describing their proposed property and project, and determining eligibility.



02. APPLY

Project Sponsor submits an application and all required documentation via email. The Program Manager is available to provide application assistance.



03. REVIEW

The Program Manager reviews the application and conducts a site visit to quantify project scope. If the project meets program requirements, the Program Manager orders all materials, coordinates installation labor, and schedule the installation with the Project Sponsor.



04. INSTALL

The installation is completed and inspected, and energy savings estimates are provided to the property and to CenterPoint Energy.
