Re: Public Utility Commission of Texas Docket No. 57957 – Application of CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Rebuild a 138 kV Transmission Line within Galveston County

On April 30, 2025, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CenterPoint Energy) notified landowners, including you, that it had filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The CCN application requested authorization for CenterPoint Energy to rebuild the existing 138 kV transmission facilities along FM 3005. The CCN application was assigned to Docket No. 57957.

The PUC issued a Notice of Approval in Docket No. 57957 on August 11, 2025, in which CenterPoint Energy was approved to rebuild the existing 138 kV transmission line. The transmission line to be rebuilt, as approved by the PUC, is shown on the enclosed map. Your property falls within 300 feet of the approved route, and CenterPoint Energy may need to obtain land or aerial rights from you. One of the first activities we will undertake is surveying across your property.
