1 Strengthening Resiliency to Withstand Extreme Weather

Our Greater Houston Resiliency Initiative includes a series of actions to improve resiliency against the impacts of hurricanes and extreme weather. In Hockley, this includes **actions to help avoid 19 million outage minutes a year** during a Beryl-like storm by:

-  **Installing 3,100+** stronger, storm-resilient poles to better withstand extreme winds up to 140 mph.
-  **Trimming/removing 410+** miles of high-risk vegetation near power lines every three years to reduce outages during storms.
-  **Installing 20+** automation devices to detect outages faster, speed up restoration and reduce impacts.

To further modernize the grid in Hockley and strengthen reliability, we will be making a series of vital electric investments to **avoid 104,000 outage minutes a year**, including:

-  **Undergrounding 5+** miles of electric distribution lines
-  **Hardening 7+** miles of transmission infrastructure

3 Building Energy Capacity to Meet Future Economic Growth


As part of our efforts to meet future economic growth, we're building brand new, high-voltage transmission lines across five miles in and around Hockley. These projects will provide meaningful benefits for Hockley families and businesses, including:

-  **Improving Storm Resiliency:** Creating a stronger, more resilient local energy grid to better withstand extreme weather, including hurricane-force winds up to 140 mph.
-  **Strengthening Community Services:** Providing approximately \$400,000 each year in property taxes, of which 50% will go directly to schools in the county.
-  **Enabling New Jobs:** Providing temporary construction jobs and permanent, high-paying local jobs.
-  **Empowering the Hockley Economy:** Supporting the local economy by working with local vendors and small businesses throughout construction.
