

Gas Price Update

Natural gas prices increase moving into September

Natural gas prices experienced an increase for September with storm activity in the Gulf of Mexico. As a whole, summer temperatures have been warmer than normal on average this year with gas volumes to power generation above 2019 levels (up 1.8 Bcf per day year-to-date) and reaching summer highs. However, increased natural gas to power generation volumes hasn't offset lower commercial and industrial demand levels, which are down 2.9 Bcf per day this year. The result is that 2020 total consumption of natural gas has been 1.2 Bcf per day lower than total consumption during the same period in 2019. Warmer forecasts appear likely to continue to boost cooling demand and ease the pace of storage injections.

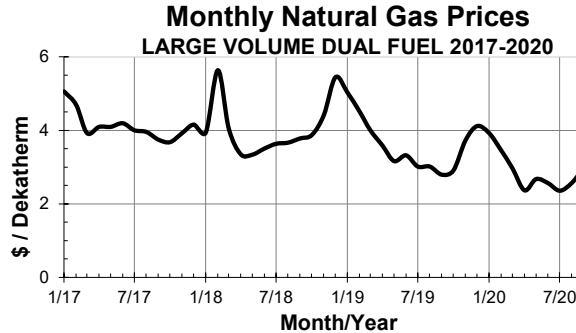
