



# Gas Price Update

## Natural gas prices drop for March

Current weather forecasts show a trend towards warmer conditions in the near term. This warming is expected to significantly reduce heating demand, pushing inventories well above average, and help keep natural gas prices low. Considering the warmer weather forecast and the moderated pace of shale production growth, natural gas prices are expected to maintain a downward trend in the short term. The U.S. Climate Prediction Center said there is a greater than 55% chance the current El Niño weather pattern will remain strong in the Northern Hemisphere through March, keeping temperatures above average. Also helping to increase natural gas inventories is the temporary closure of one of three production units at the Freeport LNG export terminal due to maintenance and repairs which will limit exports and therefore increase US natural gas inventories.
