### Natural gas prices drop again moving into June

Temperatures across much of the country have been mild, causing demand to remain low and allowing natural gas production volumes to quickly rebuild inventories at a faster pace than last year. This storage rebuild is helping to close the year-over-year gap in underground storage stocks. With near-record production, strong domestic natural gas consumption, growing exports, and rebuilding inventories, natural gas prices are low and stable moving into summer.

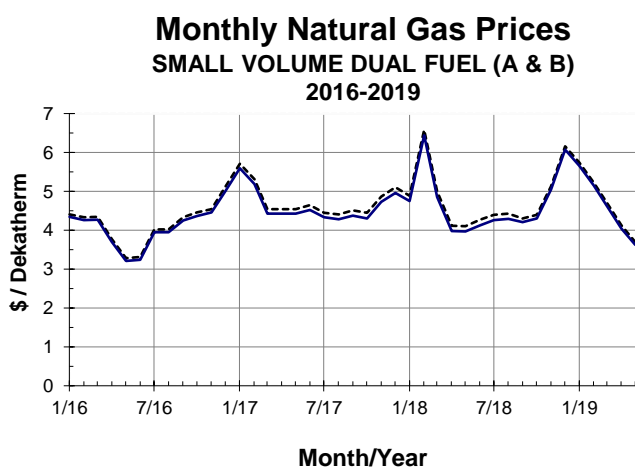
