NOTICE: CenterPoint Energy to upgrade natural gas pipelines in your neighborhood August 21 – late October 2017

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

What is CenterPoint Energy doing for construction?

For the Winnetka Pipeline system upgrade project, CenterPoint Energy replaced natural gas transmission and distribution pipeline in Brooklyn Park along 68th and 69th Avenues N. from Adair to Winnetka Avenues N. (See map on the opposite page.) Construction in Brooklyn Park began in the week of May 15 and is ending in early August 2017. Construction has begun on Winnetka Avenue N. between 68th and 55th Avenues N. in New Hope and Crystal in August and will last until late October 2017.

What is the construction between 63rd Avenue N. and Bass Lake Road, and what are the traffic plans?

Crews from Michels Corporation, an authorized CenterPoint Energy contractor, will be installing natural gas pipeline along Winnetka Avenue N. between 63rd Avenue N. and Bass Lake Road. The installation will start on August 21, 2017, and will last for approximately eight weeks. Construction will begin at 63rd Avenue N. and Bass Lake Road concurrently. The crews will work from either end of the construction route and meet in the middle. During this time, the following traffic plans will remain:

- Street parking will not be available on Winnetka Avenue N. during active construction.
- Between Bass Lake Road and 63rd Avenue N., Winnetka Avenue N. will be closed except to local traffic. In this area, there will only be one lane of southbound traffic. Northbound traffic will be closed during active construction. Detour signs will be posted on site, leading drivers back onto northbound Winnetka Avenue N. via Boone Avenue N.

The following traffic plans will change as construction progresses. **Frequent updates will be posted on CenterPoint Energy's website at CenterPointEnergy.com/Construction:**

- As the crews work along Winnetka Avenue N., intersections will be closed for up to three days before reopening. This will allow the crews to install the pipeline through an intersection.
- When the crews cross 59th Avenue N., residents living along 59th Avenue N. west of Winnetka Avenue N. will be given access to and from 59th Avenue N.
- Residents will have access to and from their driveways during active construction.


