## CenterPoint Energy to replace natural gas lines northeast of 46<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. and 42<sup>nd</sup> St. E.

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

## What will CenterPoint Energy do?

From May 3 into summer 2021, CenterPoint Energy's authorized contractors will work in Minneapolis along the following streets:

- Coffey Lane between 46th Avenue S. and Folwell Drive
- Folwell Drive between 46th Avenue S. and Edmund Boulevard
- Morrill Lane between 46th Avenue S. and Folwell Drive
- Edmund Boulevard between 42nd Street E. and Folwell Drive
- 42nd Street E. between Coffman Lane and Edmund Boulevard

While Michels Corporation will replace the natural gas main, connect the natural gas service lines to the new main, and move any inside residential meters outside, Q3 Contracting will restore the areas affected by Michels Corporation's work outside the limits of the City of Minneapolis's 42<sup>nd</sup> Street E. Reconstruction.

## What are the traffic impacts?

No full road closures will be expected for this project. Lane shifts and parking restricted on both sides of the road will be effective in areas of active construction. With any sidewalk closures, the sidewalk on the opposite side of the road will be open. Flaggers may be in place on Edmund Boulevard to help direct traffic.
