CenterPoint Energy's project is expected to end by November 13

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

Where will CenterPoint Energy be working now?

CenterPoint Energy's authorized contractors plan to finish the project by Friday, November 13. Below are the details and dates for where the crews will be working:

- By Wednesday, October 21, the intersection of Nicollet Avenue and Diamond Lake Road is expected to open. Crews from Q3 Contracting and the City of Minneapolis will have paved the intersection.
- By Wednesday, October 28, the crews plan to have restored and opened Diamond Lake Road between Pillsbury and Nicollet Avenues.
- From October 23 to November 13, the crews will close a portion of 54th Street W. heading eastbound between Lyndale and Garfield Avenues. During this time, parking entrances and sidewalks will remain open on 54th Street W. A detour route will lead drivers to northbound Lyndale Avenue, eastbound 46th Street W., and southbound Nicollet Avenue. Westbound traffic will remain open on 54th Street W. (See the images on the opposite page.)
- Please continue to patronize local businesses. The crews will place "Businesses are open" signs in this area.
- Between November 2 and 13, the crews will connect the new natural gas main, which will run
 along Diamond Lake Road from Lyndale to Stevens Avenues, to the existing intersecting mains.
 The connection locations are the following: Stevens, Nicollet, Wentworth, Harriet and Lyndale
 Avenues. The crews will work at all intersections at once. Traffic will be shifted in areas where
 the crews are working.
- By Friday, November 13, the project is expected to end. This includes the natural gas main's replacement and the road's paving. We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience.
