## CenterPoint Energy to perform Penn Ave. Belt Line Project from spring to fall 2021

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

**Project description:** From April 15 to November 2021, CenterPoint Energy's authorized contractors will work in Bloomington along Penn Avenue N. from 98th Street W. to Interstate 494. This project will happen in four phases:

- **Phase 1:** Michels Corporation will replace the first of the project's two natural gas mains. This main is a distribution main that will feed the natural gas service lines to homes and businesses.
- **Phase 2:** Michels Corporation will connect the service lines to the distribution main.
- **Phase 3:** CenterPoint Energy's authorized contractor will replace the second main. This main is a transmission main that will feed the distribution main.
- **Phase 4:** Q3 Contracting will restore the areas affected by work on the natural gas lines.

**Traffic impacts:** Work will occur in segments rather than all at once. One or two blocks will be closed at a time for a few weeks at a time. When the crews cross an intersection, each crossing will take approx. a few business days. At the end of the project, the crews will return to the north and south ends of the job to connect the new main to the existing intersecting ones.

The inspectors will work with residents on maintaining access to their homes. Lane and parking restrictions are anticipated in areas where active construction is occurring and are necessary to keep both the public and construction personnel safe.
