- To accommodate the project's deadline, the crews will close this area overnight from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, November 9, to approx. 6:00 a.m. on Monday, November 12. Detour signs will be set up during this time.
- CenterPoint Energy has secured appropriate permits from Hennepin County and the City of Bloomington.
- Construction will take place in the areas highlighted below. Lane restrictions are anticipated in areas where active construction is occurring. The lane restrictions are necessary to keep both the public and construction personnel safe.

To accommodate the project's deadline, the crews will close this area from 7:00 p.m. on Friday, November 9, to approx. 6:00 a.m. on Monday, November 12. Detour signs will lead drivers onto 86th Street, Lyndale Avenue and 90th Street. During this closure, crews from Q3 Contracting, CenterPoint Energy's authorized contractor, will restore these areas affected by Michels Corporation.

CenterPoint Energy has secured appropriate permits from Hennepin County and the City of Bloomington. We want to thank our customers for their patience during the project.

Parking and lane restrictions are required in areas where construction activity is occurring and is necessary to keep both the public and construction personnel safe.
