## NOTICE: CenterPoint Energy to upgrade natural gas pipelines in your neighborhood June 18 – Winter 2018

- Michels Corporation, a CenterPoint Energy authorized contractor, will begin the natural gas system replacement in the Minneapolis neighborhood along the following streets:
  - o W. 61st Street between Lyndale Avenue S. and Nicollet Avenue
  - o W. 60<sup>th</sup> Street between Pillsbury Avenue S. and Nicollet Avenue
  - o Harriet Avenue between W. 60<sup>th</sup> Street and W. 61<sup>st</sup> Street
- CenterPoint Energy's construction is expected to begin on Monday, June 18, and will last for the rest of the 2018 season.
- Construction will take place in the areas highlighted below. Lane restrictions are anticipated in areas where active construction is occurring. The lane restrictions are necessary to keep both the public and construction personnel safe.

## NOTICE: CenterPoint Energy to upgrade natural gas pipelines in your neighborhood June 18 – Winter 2018

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

CenterPoint Energy will be replacing the natural gas system in coordination with the City of Minneapolis's "61st Street West Reconstruction" project, which has begun this year and will last throughout the 2018 construction season. CenterPoint Energy's construction is expected to begin on June 18 and will last for the rest of the 2018 season. Parking and lane restrictions are required in areas where construction activity is occurring and is necessary to keep both the public and construction personnel safe. Michels Corporation, an authorized CenterPoint Energy contractor, will replace the existing natural gas mains along the following streets:

- W. 61<sup>st</sup> Street between Lyndale Avenue S. and Nicollet Avenue
- W. 60<sup>th</sup> Street between Pillsbury Avenue S. and Nicollet Avenue
- Harriet Avenue between W. 60<sup>th</sup> Street and W. 61<sup>st</sup> Street

Construction will happen in three phases: <a href="Phase 1">Phase 1</a> consists of installing the natural gas distribution main. <a href="Phase 2">Phase 2</a> is connecting the individual customer gas service lines to the new gas distribution main. This may include service line replacement and relocating gas meters from inside the home to outside. Customers will experience a short disruption of gas service as the crews are installing the gas service line. Crews may have to dig in the ground on your property in the utility easement to complete the task of service and main distribution line replacement. <a href="Phase 3">Phase 3</a> is the restoration of disturbed areas affected by our work outside the city construction zone. This may consist of lawn restoration and sidewalk or street restoration as work dictates.
