Dear property owner,

To comply with state and federal regulations for natural gas pipeline safety and maintenance, CenterPoint Energy and its contractors will need to replace a section of pipe beginning the middle of July 2016, which was inspected in 2015. A portion of the natural gas pipeline runs under your property, an area for which CenterPoint Energy has a transmission pipeline easement with maintenance rights above and on each side of its natural gas pipelines. This work will be accomplished by digging over the pipeline using various pieces of equipment.

To do the work described in this letter, CenterPoint Energy will need to work in the area immediately above the pipeline and will access the location using our easement. Any materials, fences, vehicles, obstructions, vegetation or trees not permitted by law to be over the pipeline will be removed and/or cleared. We will attempt to preserve permitted vegetation when possible. CenterPoint Energy will have a fence company come in and remove fences in the easement area and have them replaced after the completion of the project, at CenterPoint Energy's cost. Further, CenterPoint Energy will have our restoration contractor restore grass vegetation.
