- In preparation for a Hennepin County paving project, CenterPoint Energy will replace approximately 1,500 feet of 8-inch steel pipe with 1,500 feet of new 8-inch steel pipe and replace approximately 15 scattered natural gas service lines.
- CenterPoint Energy's construction is anticipated to start in mid-July 2015 and will require approximately two and a half weeks to complete the work.
- CenterPoint Energy will be working within the railroad's closure of Old Shakopee Road.

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

In preparation for a Hennepin County paving project, Michels Corporation, an authorized CenterPoint Energy contractor, will be replacing approximately 1,500 feet of 8-inch steel pipe with 1,500 feet of new 8-inch steel pipe along Old Shakopee Road, from Morris Avenue S. to just east of Irwin Avenue S (see map for detail). Construction is expected to begin in July 2015 and will require two and a half weeks to complete the work. CenterPoint Energy will be working within the railroad's closure of Old Shakopee Road. We will restore the areas affected by our construction in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local regulations.

The work will also include the replacement of approximately 15 scattered natural gas service lines. Representatives from CenterPoint Energy will contact residents whose gas service may be affected to schedule the necessary construction work on their property. In addition, your gas meter will be evaluated and replaced if necessary. If the gas meter is located inside your home or building, we will move it to an outside location.
