At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

As a system upgrade paving project, Michels Corporation, an authorized CenterPoint Energy contractor, will be replacing approximately 600 feet of 24-inch steel pipe and smaller plastic pipe with 1,000 feet of 24-inch steel pipe and 200 feet of 2-inch plastic pipe along 34 and 33 ½ Streets East, from Elliot Avenue S. to 10 Avenue S. and along 10 Avenue S., from just south of 34 Street E. to 33 ½ Street E (see map for detail).

Construction is expected to begin the week of July 27, 2015 and will require one month to complete the work. We will restore the areas affected by our construction in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local regulations.
