CenterPoint Energy to replace natural gas pipelines in your neighborhood beginning August 31, 2015

Dear Property Owner,

At CenterPoint Energy, we are committed to providing timely and relevant information to our customers and the general public to minimize inconvenience or disruption due to our construction activities.

In preparation for a 2016 pipeline inspection project, Michels Corporation, an authorized CenterPoint Energy contractor, will be replacing a farm tap with approximately 10 feet of pipe at the east highlighted area and inserting a camera at the west highlighted area below. Construction is anticipated to start on Monday, August 31 and will require approximately three days to complete the work. We will restore the areas affected by our construction in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local regulations.

The in-line inspection is performed using a sophisticated electronic device that is inserted into the pipeline to inspect for corrosion and other defects or anomalies. The electronic device commonly referred to as a PIG in the natural gas industry is battery powered and travels very slowly through the pipeline gathering and recording critical inspection data. In order for the PIG to travel as efficiently as possible, there will be approximately eight locations where the pipe will need to be replaced.
