HOUSTON MAYOR ORDERS DISCONNECTION OF CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PREMISES:

- At the order of Houston Mayor Sylvester Turner, CenterPoint Energy will be turning off power to about 4,600 residential premises included in the Mayor's mandatory evacuation order (south of Interstate 10, west of Gessner Road, north of Briar Forest Drive and east of the Addicks and Barker reservoirs).
- The City of Houston is providing CenterPoint Energy the addresses of premises that are flooded. This order does **not** apply to premises that have not been impacted by flooding. Disconnections will begin as early as 7 a.m. tomorrow, 9/3.
- Due to the large number of premises involved in this action, the method CNP will use to accomplish the disconnections will <u>not</u> generate a 650_04 transaction to the CR. We will produce a list for each CR of premises involved in this action.
- We will restore power when Mayor Sylvester Turner directs us to do so.
- This is a rapidly developing issue, and we will update the market when we have more information.
