**LONG DESCRIPTION:** CenterPoint Energy continues to closely Monitor the Weather and Take Actions to Prepare for Potential Wildfire Risk. The National Weather Service issued a Fire Weather Watch for large portions of Texas including the Greater Houston area on Saturday from noon to 9 p.m. Due to the potentially dangerous weather conditions CenterPoint Energy is actively preparing its response, including conducting pre-inspections, adjusting power line safety settings, communicating with customers, and working closely with local emergency agencies.
