

SUBJECT: CNP Implementation of Interim Distribution Cost Recovery Factor (DCRF) Rates Effective June 1, 2026

NOTICE DATE: April 16, 2026

SHORT DESCRIPTION: CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC’s Interim Distribution Cost Recovery Factor (DCRF) and Wholesale Distribution Cost Recovery Factor (WDCRF) Rates will be effective June 1, 2026.

INTENDED AUDIENCE: Competitive Retailers

DAY AFFECTED: June 1, 2026

LONG DESCRIPTION: On February 27, 2026, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (“CenterPoint Houston”) filed, Docket No. **59424**, with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“Commission”) an Application to Amend its Distribution Cost Recovery Factor (“DCRF”) pursuant to 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE (“TAC”) §25.243. On April 16, 2026, the presiding officer in this proceeding issued Order No. 6 approving the implementation of interim rates, consistent with the rates shown below, effective for meters read on and after June 1, 2026, pending final resolution of this case. The interim rates are subject to surcharge or refund as determined by the final order that will be issued by the Commission in Docket No. 59424.

The DCRF is an interim rate adjustment allowed by Texas statute that permits electric utilities to implement new rates to account for changes in distribution invested capital without filing a full rate case.

Pending the issuance of a final decision by the Commission in Docket No. 59424, the Rider DCRF & WDCRF interim rates will include the following charges on bills rendered to REPs:

Rate Class	DCRF Charge	Billing Units
Residential Service	\$ 0.004944	per kWh
Secondary Service Less Than or Equal to 10 kVA	\$ 0.004508	per kWh
Secondary Service Greater Than 10 kVA	\$ 0.796213	per Billing kVA
Primary Service and Wholesale Distribution Service	\$ 0.371995	per Billing kVA
Transmission Service	\$ 0.009819	per 4CP kVA
Lighting Services	\$ 0.084803	per kWh
